<b>andro</b>	a steroid
<b>belly shirt</b>	provocative clothing
<b>black box</b>	medicine warning
<b>cell walker</b>	a pedestrian on a cell phone
<b>Cialis</b>	trademark for a medicine popularly pushed on Web
<b>CSI effect</b>	impact of television programming on jury expectations
<b>-dar</b>	ability to recognize someone's characteristics, as in gaydar, bi-dar, and straightdar
<b>dual-core</b>	of a computer with more than one processor
<b>flash mob</b>	seemingly spontaneous gathering prompted by cell-phoning
<b>gump, v.</b>	to place the image of a person in a historical setting. Also <i>Gump effect, Gump factor, Gump syndrome</i>
<b>kangaroo care</b>	close physical contact between an infant and parent
<b>low-cut</b>	provocative clothing
<b>pedrage</b>	uncontrollable anger in a pedestrian over pedlock—pedestrian gridlock
